Be considerate, and try parking on
Longdraft before using up a visitor
space.

Visitor Parking Guidelines



Each homeowner will receive one (1) Visitor Parking Permit with the homeowner's address on it.

Any vehicle parked in a Visitor space between the hours of 2:00 am and 7:00 am without displaying a Visitor Parking Permit will be towed.

Any vehicle that remains in a Visitor space for more than 14 consecutive nights will be towed.



Requests for an exception to any of the guidelines must be submitted to the Bennington Community Association administrator, and will be considered for approval on a case-by-case basis. The Board of Directors reserves the right to adjudicate such requests.

Parking a concern for you? Here's how you can get involved!

→ Be a considerate neighbor! We have many needs in our community and an abundance of Visitor parking spaces. Be sure to not leave your car in a Visitor space for long periods of time. (See parking guidelines for maximum time allotted.)

→ Notice a parking violation? Fill out the Parking Violation form, which can be found on the Bennington website, so that our administrator is notified and can take the next appropriate step.

→ Attend HOA meetings and consider joining the Parking Committee! HOA meetings are held the 4th Tuesday of each month, 7:30 pm.
